

THE REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACTS

Volume of abstract should not exceed 3 pages in black-and-white form. Only maps can be color.

Abstract should be typed in Microsoft Word (any version).

- Format of abstract:**
- font – Times New Roman, Regular;
 - font size – 14 pt;
 - line spacing – single;
 - indention – 1 cm;
 - automatically hyphenate document;
 - alignment - on widht;
 - without page numbers.

- Page setup:**
- paper size – A4 (210x297);
 - orientation – portrait;
 - margins – top 2 cm, botton 2 cm, left 3 cm, right 1.5 cm.

- Tables and figures:**
- for wide tables can be use Landscape orientation of page;
 - figures should be inserted in document and also sent as additional file .JPG with resolution 300 dpi.

Ecological monitoring is the most important tool of control for state of environmental, nature ecosystems and its important component - vegetation. Vegetation monitoring is a system of long-term and regular observations over current state of vegetation objects and its habitats, as well as assessment and forecast of vegetation changes with aim of biodiversity conservation, sustainability maintenance and rational use of resources, based on phytosociological methods.

The Institute of Experimental Botany leads vegetation monitoring direction in the National System of Environmental Monitoring in Republic of Belarus. Every 5 years the Institute conducts conferences on vegetation monitoring. 5th conference will be held in October 2018 in the National Park "Bialowieza".

The goal of the conference is to discuss outlook, opportunities and problems of vegetation monitoring and effective use of monitoring results for nature management and environment protection.

PLACE OF THE CONFERENCE

Bialowieza National Park – an amazing corner of Belarussian nature belongs to the realm of old-growth forest which has been living without much human intervention for almost 800 years



THE CONFERENCE TOPICS:

- current problems of vegetation monitoring: methodologies, systems, methods, means of processing and interpretation of results;
- monitoring and assessment of forest vegetation;
- monitoring and assessment of meadow, mire and water vegetation;
- monitoring of vegetation resources;
- monitoring of rare plants and fungi species and its habitats;
- monitoring of harmful invasive plants species;
- monitoring of protective plantations on agricultural lands;
- monitoring and assessment of green plantations under anthropogenic impact;
- monitoring of vegetation at protected areas (reserves territories);
- practical application of monitoring results
- innovation methodics in vegetation monitoring and assessment

THE TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

Abstracts should be sent in electronic form (by e-mail). Name of the file - Latin transliteration of the first author Last Name (for example: ivanov.doc).

Registration form should be sent by e-mail and contain next Informations:

1. Last Name, First Name of the author.
2. Organization (Institution).
3. Position.
4. Title and Degree.
5. Contact Address (of organization).
6. Phone, Fax, E-mail.
7. Title of the Abstract.
8. Form of participation (report, poster or in absentia).

Timeline of conference:

- reception of registration form and abstract - before **May 31, 2018**;
- confirmation of participation - before **June 31, 2018**;
- confirmation of your participation for reservation of hotel - before **August 31, 2018**;

Languages:

Belarussian, Russian, English

Registration fee will be 70 euros (160 BYN) for scientists and 40 euros (95 BYN) for students.

Expenses covered by the registration fee includes printing of the Materials, rent of bus to the place of Conference and back, dinner, scientific excursions on objects of vegetation monitoring.

In the case of participation in absentia registration fee will be 15 euros (35 BYN). It includes partly publication and sending of books "The Materials of the Conference"
